

With Pot Rules Relaxed, More U.S. Teens Driving While High

America's roads are notoriously unsafe on holidays, and a new study shows that marijuana legalization could be making the situation even worse.

Almost half of teenagers who regularly use pot admit they've gotten behind the wheel while stoned, a new study in *JAMA Network Open* reveals. Overall, twice as many teens report driving under the influence of marijuana than admit to drinking and driving, according to results drawn from a federal survey on youth risk behaviors.
