New legislation to assist you with more professional development opportunities next school year.

HB 489 has a great opportunity for educators to be compensated for the professional work they're doing beyond their regular contract. Through this recently passed legislation, certified educators who work in LEAs across the state can be compensated for up to 32 extra hours of work for qualifying activities including evaluating student data, participating in professional learning, collaborating in PLCs, planning instruction, or developing strategies to reach specific students. Educators will need to have a plan shared with their principals by the 5th day of instruction of how they intend to use these hours. The extra hours must be claimed for work done outside of regular contract hours. For more information contact your LEA's business administration or human resources office.

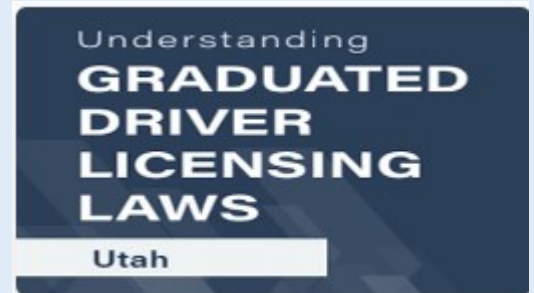
