The most failed class at HHS is Credit Recovery.

Reviewed AP testing statistics. Math and English are doing well. Some of the social studies disciplines need improvement.

Reviewed ASPIRE testing statistics. One problem that was identified is that the ASPIRE testing is not mandatory and so we lose some of the student population. English and Reading are trending up while Math and Science (10th Grade Biology) are trending down.
