#### **Teen Driving Experience and Exposure**

Once teenagers begin driving independently, the crash risk increases significantly at licensure and remains high during the first few months of solo driving.

BTSCRP Research Report 13: Outcomes of Variability in Teen Driving Experience and Exposure: Evidence from Naturalistic Driving Studies was released this week from TRB's Behavioral Traffic Safety Cooperative Research Program. As part of the study, the authors found:

- Teens with more supervised driving practice during the learner's permit phase have fewer crashes.
- Night and unfamiliar-route practice reduces risky behaviors.
- Many teens don't meet minimum-hour requirements for permit-phase practice. Using tracking apps improve compliance.
- Speeding is common on both low- and high-speed roads.
- Parental involvement after licensure is low but beneficial.
