Tristan also competed at the state level and was the WINNER!

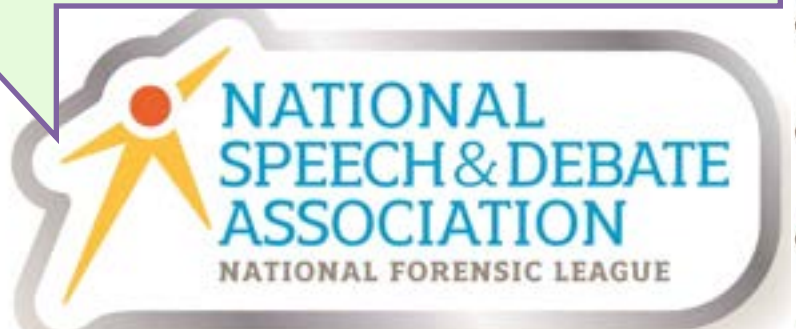
