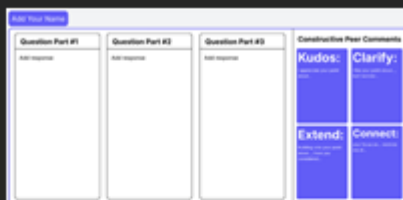



Safe Roads Driving Challenge

As a part of our team of driver educators, you know great driver education works and we are out to prove it.

With Street Smarts, we're launching the **Safe Roads Challenge – Utah**, a statewide initiative that gathers real-time driving analytics through a mobile app. We are providing it to you at no cost to download and engage with so we can gather driving analytics that Lecticon will present at the UDTSEA Conference on April 26 during their session: "**From Gut Feel to Hard Data: Proving Driver Ed Works.**"

We are looking at the opportunity to provide the Challenge to all our student drivers to help gather driving information across the state and learn more about what's working and the challenges they face. State Challenges are currently taking place in Florida, Washington, and Hawai'i, with the next launch in Idaho.

Getting Started (3 Easy Steps)
