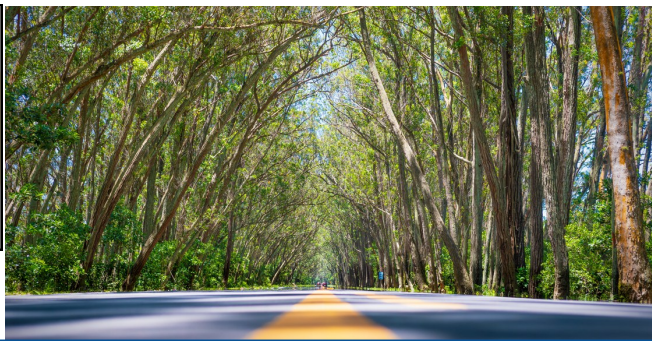

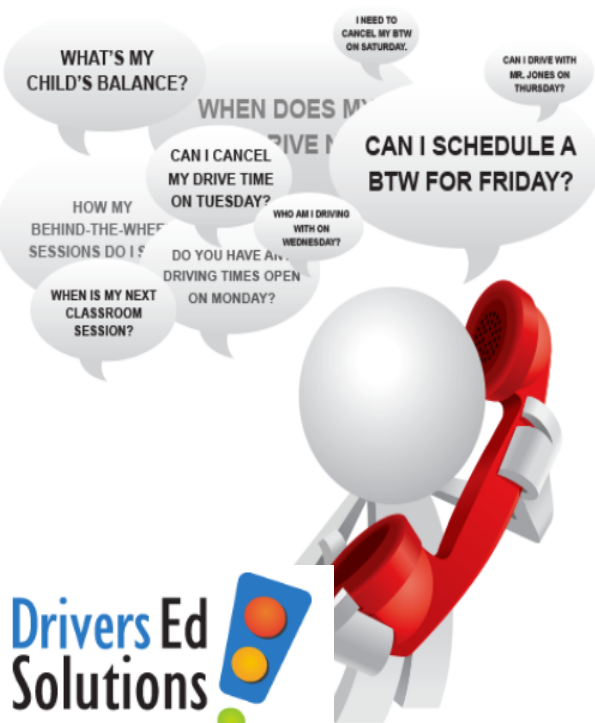

Organizing Your Schedule

- Add new courses easily -- just **duplicate** and change the dates.
- **Limit the drives** students can schedule in advance, per week, or per month.
- Set the number of **mandatory days** required between drives.
- Cancel a period and be **prompted to notify the affected students**.
- **Add/remove periods** with just a few clicks. Set periods in five minute increments.
- **Share your centralized courses** across regional boundaries.
- Allow students to add themselves to **waitlists** for drive times.

Communicating with Customers

- Allow instructors to email, text, and **schedule their students**.
- Send parents **enrollment links** for specific courses.
- Create **custom form letters** that send to students upon registration.
- **Upload documents** to display on your website and attach to form letters.
- Include a **customized contract** for students/parents to sign at registration.
- Generate **drive evaluations** during lessons or road tests.



Driver Education Newsletter Reminders

Important updates, safety reminders, and resources for the new school year

Student Driving and Campus Safety Reminder

Reminder: Students with learner permits must have a qualified parent, guardian, or approved adult in the vehicle when driving to or from driver education activities on campus. Students should not drive themselves to class, range, or roadway drives without proper supervision.

Permit Verification

Check permits before instruction begins. Students must have a valid Utah learner permit to participate. Out-of-state permits are not valid for Utah driver education.

★ Best Practice Reminders

Use range cars wisely: Place more than one student in a range car when appropriate and teach passengers to observe and help the driver stay focused.

Document carefully: Record who is in each range car, including vehicle number, when range time counts toward drive or observation time.

Plan roadway drives: Schedule three students when possible; if only two are scheduled and one is absent, the drive may need to be canceled.

Keep drives focused: Use shorter, skill-based drives when appropriate so students have time to practice between sessions.

Provide feedback: Practice required maneuvers or skills on every drive, grade each drive, and share feedback with the student and parent.
