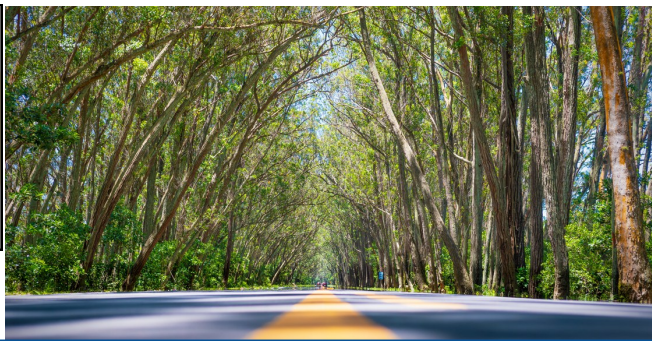

Behavior Support and Prevention Summit

The USBE Behavior Support and Prevention teams are hosting a free two-day Behavior Solutions Customized Workshop designed to help educators establish and implement proactive, tiered behavior supports.

Based on the work of Dr. John Hannigan and colleagues, this training bridges the gap between academic and social behavior instruction through a systematic framework that moves beyond theory and into practical application. Participants will leave with a customized behavior support framework they can implement in their schools.

Policy Reminders — Driver Education Policy Manual: [Law and Policy Driver Education Manual](#)

Face-to-face classroom instruction: Minimum of 27 USBE-approved clock hours.

Online or hybrid classroom instruction: Minimum of 30 USBE-approved clock hours, facilitated by a qualified driver education instructor.

Scheduling limits: No more than **10 classroom hours in seven days or 3 hours per day**.

Class size: Maximum of **36 students per classroom and 90 students per online teacher**.

Students must receive at least **6 hours of driving and 6 hours of observation**.

Instruction must occur in a dual-control vehicle on a public roadway under a qualified instructor.

Students **may not drive more than 1 hour per day or observe more than 2 hours per day**.

When program needs require it, students **may drive up to 90 minutes per day in two 45-minute intervals separated by a break or observation period**.

Students **may not receive more than 3 hours of in-car instruction in a seven-day period**.

Each drive must include written objectives, detailed feedback, and a complete driving log.
